

WARNING AGAINST FRAUDULENT CALLS AND E-MAILS

We would like to remind you of the importance of remaining vigilant regarding the security of your personal information as well as that of your company. Rest assured that the AEMQ and the Xplor team do not divulge or commercialize the information of its members, participants or exhibitors.

Examples of fraudulent communication:

Attendee list scam:

You may receive communications from companies offering to purchase a list of attendees or exhibitors. Once again, the AEMQ and the Xplor team do not share or sell information about our members, participants or exhibitors. As an exhibitor, the only way to obtain this information is to collect it yourself during the convention.

Hotel reservation fraud:

You may receive offers to help you book hotel rooms at a discounted rate. However, please note that neither the hotels nor the AEMQ representatives or Xplor team will contact you directly to book your stay. You must contact the hotel of your choice directly, or use the link in the Xplor toolbox (for reservations at the Westin Montreal). Hotel contact details are available on our home page.

Important reminders:

- Never divulge personal or financial information over the phone or by e-mail.
- Don't give in to pressure to act quickly.
